

METHODOLOGY

On behalf of FWD.us, Public Opinion Strategies completed an online survey of 1,004 registered voters nationally.


The survey was conducted March 9-12, 2021 and has a confidence interval of <u>+</u>3.53%.






Key Poll Findings

The mood of the country is significantly more positive than the NBC poll taken right around inaugural.



A clear majority of Americans approve of the job that Biden is doing as President.







Do you strongly approve, somewhat approve, somewhat disapprove, or strongly disapprove of the job Joe Biden is doing as President?






Do you strongly approve, somewhat approve, somewhat disapprove, or strongly disapprove of the job Joe Biden is doing as President?

Among younger Americans...






Do you strongly approve, somewhat approve, somewhat disapprove, or strongly disapprove of the job Joe Biden is doing as President?



Two-thirds of Americans say undocumented immigrants living in the US should be able to earn their citizenship rather than be deported.








Do you believe that undocumented farmworkers who are working in the United States should be allowed to earn their citizenship after passing a background check, or do you believe as many as possible should be deported?















A majority of Americans say they would be more likely to vote for a candidate for US Senate if that candidate supported legislation to protect "dreamers" from legislation.




