

# Immigrants Are Major Contributors to Nevada's Education Services

**Immigrants of all backgrounds boost Nevada's education services.**

Some 13,000 immigrants, or about 58% of all immigrants in the education services, are U.S. citizens. About 5,000 are lawful permanent residents, and 1,000 are temporary immigrants on a nonimmigrant visa.

**Dreamers**—undocumented immigrants who came to the U.S. as children before 2021 and are either in school or have graduated from high school—number 1,000 workers in Nevada's education services. Some 1,000 are Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) recipients.

**Immigrant groups protected from deportation**—DACA recipients, TPS holders, people seeking asylum, and those waiting for a permanent residency visa—**have access to work permits, making up an estimated 1,000 education services workers in Nevada.**
