

Immigrants Make MT-2 Stronger

*An estimated **9,000** immigrants live in MT-2, making up **2%** of the total population.*

*Immigrants live in **3%** of households in MT-2.*

Immigrants contribute to every sector of MT-2's economy. Some 2% of MT-2's labor force are immigrants, including 2% of manufacturing, and 4% of business services.

Immigrants of all backgrounds boost MT-2's communities. Some 4,000 immigrants, or about 48% of all immigrants in MT-2, are U.S. citizens. About 2,000 are lawful permanent residents.

Some 3,000, are either undocumented immigrants or live with an undocumented immigrant. Some 1,000 undocumented individuals in MT-2 have lived in the U.S. for more than 10 years.

Dreamers—undocumented immigrants who came to the U.S. as children before 2021 and are either in school or have graduated from high school—number 1,000 and **contribute \$23 million annually to MT-2's economy.** Some 1,000 are Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) recipients.
