

# Immigrants Are Major Contributors to Nevada's Business Services

*An estimated **60,000** immigrants work in Nevada's business services, making up **24%** of Nevada's business services workforce.*

**Immigrants of all backgrounds boost Nevada's business services.** Some 23,000 immigrants, or about 38% of all immigrants in Nevada's business services, are U.S. citizens. About 9,000 are lawful permanent residents, and 6,000 are temporary immigrants on a nonimmigrant visa.

**Dreamers**—undocumented immigrants who came to the U.S. as children before 2021 and are either in school or have graduated from high school—number 3,000 workers in Nevada's business services. Some 2,000 are Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) recipients.

Annual combined taxes paid by immigrant business services workers

**Immigrant groups protected from deportation**—DACA recipients, TPS holders, people seeking asylum, and those waiting for a permanent residency visa—**have access to work permits, making up an estimated 7,000 business services workers in Nevada.**
