

Immigrants Make OH-6 Stronger

*An estimated **15,000** immigrants live in OH-6, making up **2%** of the total population.*

*Immigrants live in **3%** of households in OH-6.*

Immigrants of all backgrounds boost OH-6's communities. Some 7,000 immigrants, or about 45% of all immigrants in OH-6, are U.S. citizens. About 2,000 are lawful permanent residents, and 2,000 are temporary immigrants (including nonimmigrant visa holders and international students).

Some 8,000 are either undocumented immigrants or live with an undocumented immigrant. Some 2,000 U.S. citizen children in OH-6 live with an undocumented parent, while some 1,000 undocumented individuals in OH-6 have lived in the U.S. for more than 10 years.

Dreamers—undocumented immigrants who came to the U.S. as children before 2021 and are either in school or have graduated from high school—number 1,000 and **contribute \$18 million annually to OH-6's economy.**

An estimated 1,000 immigrants in OH-6 are waiting for a decision on their asylum claim, and contribute \$23 million to OH-6's economy annually.
